


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Where does the FCDL fall in the E-Rate process?







The Basics



What is an FCDL?

USAC issues a Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) to both the applicant and the service provider after the review of an FCC Form 471 has been completed.

The FCDL notifies the applicant of the funding decisions that have been made with regard to each individual Funding Request Number (FRN) - approved funding amounts and modified or denied funding amounts.

The FCDL summarizes the E-Rate funds that have been committed for discounts that had been requested on a Form 471 for eligible services.

The FCDL will indicate any rejections of requested discounts on services deemed ineligible or in situations where the applicant was not in compliance with program rules, and will also offer the reasoning behind the decision.

FCDLs are issued in funding waves.



How do I obtain my FCDL?

Applicants will collect their FCDL via email and/or inside the EPC portal:

- The contact and certifier for any given Form 471 application will receive an email notifying him or her that an FCDL has been issued for a specific application. The email will contain two attachments a PDF file with the FCDL and a CSV file with the main data points of the decision.
- If the organization filed multiple FCC Forms 471 and more than one is included in the same wave, the certifier will receive an email for each form.
- Any user for the organization can also log into EPC and view the FCDL.




Locating an FCDL in EPC

Locating an FCDL

(1) In the **Notifications** section of the organization's landing page, use the "Notification Type" drop down menu to select "FCDL"

Understanding Your FCDL





The Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) is providing this information to both the applicant(s) and the service provider(s) so that all parties are aware of the postcommitment changes related to their funding requests and can work together to complete the funding process for these requests.

Next Steps

 Work with your service provider(s) to determine if your bills will be discounted or if you will request reimbursement from USAC after paying the undiscounted cost for the services you receive.

 Review the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) requirements and file the FCC Form 486 (Service Confirmation and CIPA Certification Form). The deadline to submit this form is 120 days from the date of this letter or from the service start date (whichever is later).

3. Invoice USAC

 If you (the applicant) are invoicing USAC: You must pay your service provider(s) the undiscounted cost for the services you receive and file the FCC Form 472, the Billed Entity Applicant Reimbursement (BEAR) Form, to invoice USAC for reimbursement of the discounted cost of services.

 If your service provider(s) are invoicing USAC: The service provider(s) must provide services, bill the applicant at the discounted rate, and file the FCC Form 474, the Service Provider Invoice (SPI) form, to invoice USAC for reimbursement for the discounted portion of costs. Each funding year, service providers must file an FCC Form 473, the Service Provider Annual Certification Form, to be able to submit invoices and to receive disbursements.

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



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

3. Invoice USAC

- If you (the applicant) are invoicing USAC: You must pay your service provider(s) the full cost for the services you receive and file the <u>FCC Form 472</u>, the Billed Entity Applicant Reimbursement (BEAR) Form, to invoice USAC for reimbursement of the discounted amount.
- If your service provider(s) is invoicing USAC: The service provider(s) must provide services, bill the applicant for the non-discounted share, and file the <u>FCC Form 474</u>, the Service Provider Invoice (SPI) form, to invoice USAC for reimbursement for the discounted portion of costs. Every funding year, service providers must file an <u>FCC Form 473</u>, the Service Provider Annual Certification Form, to be able to submit invoices and to receive disbursements.
- To receive an invoice deadline extension, the applicant or service provider must request an extension on or before the last date to invoice. If you anticipate, for any reason, that invoices cannot be filed on time, USAC will grant a one-time, 120-day invoice deadline extension if timely requested.

How to Appeal or Request a Waiver of a Decision

You can appeal or request a waiver of a decision in this letter within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Failure to meet this deadline will result in an automatic dismissal of your appeal or waiver request.

Note: The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) will not accept appeals of USAC decisions that have not first been appealed to USAC. However, if you are seeking a waiver of E-rate program rules, you must submit your request to the FCC and not to USAC. USAC is not able to waive the E-rate program rules.

- To submit your appeal to USAC, visit the Appeals section in the <u>E-rate Productivity Center (EPC)</u> and provide the required information. USAC will reply to your appeal submissions to confirm receipt. Visit USAC's <u>website</u> for additional information on submitting an appeal to USAC, including step-bystep instructions.
- To request a waiver of the FCC's rules, please submit it to the FCC in proceeding number CC Docket No. 02-6 using the <u>Electronic Comment Filing System</u> (ECFS). Include your contact information, a statement that your filing is a waiver request, identifying information, the FCC rule(s) for which you are seeking a waiver, a full description of the relevant facts that you believe support your waiver request and any related relief, and any supporting documentation.

For appeals to USAC or to the FCC, be sure to keep a copy of your entire appeal, including any correspondence and documentation, and provide a copy to the affected service provider(s).

Obligation to Pay Non-Discount Portion

Applicants are required to pay the non-discount portion of the cost of the eligible products and/or services to their service providers. Service providers are required to bill applicants for the non-discount portion of costs for the eligible products and/or services. The FCC stated that requiring applicants to pay the non-discounted share of costs ensures efficiency and accountability in the program. If using the BEAR invoicing method, the applicant must pay the service provider in full (the non-discount plus discount portion) before seeking reimbursement from USAC. If using the SPI invoicing method, the service provider must first bill the applicant before invoicing USAC.

Notice on Rules and Funds Availability

The applicants' receipt of funding commitments is contingent on their compliance with all statutory, regulatory, and procedural requirements of the Schools and Libraries Program and the FCC's rules. Applicants who have received funding commitments continue to be subject to audits and other reviews that USAC and/or the FCC may undertake to assure that committed funds are being used in accordance with such requirements. USAC may be required to reduce or cancel funding commitments that were not issued in accordance with such requirements, whether due to action or inaction of USAC, the applicant, or the service provider. USAC, and other appropriate authorities (including but not limited to the FCC), may pursue enforcement actions and other means of recourse to collect improperly disbursed funds.

Next Steps



What do I do with the FCDL?

- Carefully review the FCDL for details on whether a request was approved or denied, and any adjustments that might have been made to the original request.
- If you disagree with a funding commitment decision, an appeal letter MUST be received by USAC within 60 days of the date of the decision letter.



What do I do next?

Make a note of the date of FCDL so you are aware of the deadline for filing a Form 486.

You will have 120 days after the date of your FCDL or the start of services (whichever is later) to complete the Form 486 without penalty.

NOTE: you cannot file a Form 486 for any given FRN before receiving an FCDL for that FRN



What do I save for my files?

 \star Save all records for at least 10 years from the last date of service \star

• A copy of the FCDL file
