- Be a student in TRIO Student Support Services at USM and attending USM this fall 2020 as a matriculated degree seeking student working toward first bachelor's degree AND
- Must be eligible to apply for Federal financial aid as an eligible US citizen or noncitizen AND
- Meet at least ONE of the eligibility below:
 - 1) Neither parent graduated from a four-year college OR
 - 2) Meet government income guidelines based on taxable income OR
 - 3) Have a documented physical, medical, psychological, or learning disability
